ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

As part of the Suicide Awareness Week 2009, Samaritans of Singapore (SOS) will be conducting a one-day Suicide Postvention Workshop.

This one-day workshop, facilitated by experienced SOS staff, will provide an overview of suicide postvention with survivors.

'Postvention' refers to intervention conducted after a suicide death. 'Survivors' in this context refer to family members and loved ones left behind when a suicide death takes place.

This workshop will help participants:

- Understand suicide grief.
- Explore the impact of suicide on survivors.
- Discuss postventions that facilitate healing in survivors.
- Practise suicide postvention skills.

Methodology

The workshop comprises short lectures, video clips, role plays, small group discussions and exercises. It will be conducted by trained SOS practitioners with local hands-on experience.
