Adj Assoc Prof Lee Cheng is a practising psychiatrist and a senior consultant at the Institute of Mental Health (IMH). He is currently the Vice Chairman Medical Board (Clinical) at IMH since March 2012. He was the Chief of the Department of Community Psychiatry at IMH from September 2004 to March 2014 and the Programme Director of the Community Mental Health Team, a project funded under the National Mental Health Blueprint by Ministry of Health from 2007 to 2017.

Adj Assoc Prof Lee held the position of President of Silver Ribbon Singapore (SRS) from 2011 to 2017. He remains as a Board member of SRS. He is the Vice President for Singapore Association for Mental Health and is currently in his 2nd term as a Board Council member for National Council of Social Service. He is also the President for Singapore Psychiatric Association.

Adj Assoc Prof Lee is a Clinical Senior Lecturer at Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore and Adjunct Associate Professor, Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine. He is a regular presenter at many international and regional scientific meetings. He also writes on a monthly basis for the local Chinese newspaper, 'Shin Min Daily News'.

Adj Assoc Prof Lee is a recipient of the 2017 Friends of MSF Award. In 2014, he received the 2014 National Healthcare Group (NHG) Distinguished Achievement Award. He also received the Public Service (PS21) Star Service Award in 2010 and the Healthcare Humanity Award in 2008.
